TOWN BOARD RESOLUTION**

TOWN OF VAN BUREN LOCAL LAW C OF 2017

_____ introduced proposed Local Law No. C-2017, “Amending Chapter 200 of the Code of the Town of Van Buren titled ‘Zoning’,” which Local Law will amend the regulations for the Planned Unit Development District to include a fee in lieu of parkland, was seconded by _____.

WHEREAS, no other agency has the legal authority or jurisdiction to approve or directly undertake the enactment of a local law in the Town of Van Buren.

WHEREAS, a short EAF in support of this local law has been prepared and has been reviewed by the Town Board; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board has considered the adoption of said Local Law, has considered the criteria contained in 6 N.Y.C.R.R. Part 617.7 and has compared the impacts which may be reasonably expected to result from the adoption of said Local Law against said criteria.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is

RESOLVED AND DETERMINED, that there are no other involved agencies within the meaning of the New York State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQR) with respect to the proposed enactment of this Local Law, with the result that the Town Board shall act as lead agency in this matter, and that the enactment of proposed Local Law No. C-2017 is an unlisted action; and it is further

RESOLVED AND DETERMINED, the Town Board upon review of the short EAF has determined this action will have no adverse impact on the environment and that this resolution shall constitute a negative declaration under SEQRA and it is further

RESOLVED, that the Town Board shall conduct a public hearing as to the enactment of proposed Local Law No. C-2017 at the Town Hall located at 7575 Van Buren Road in the Town on April 18, 2017 at 7:30 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter can be heard, at which time all persons interested in the subject shall be heard.
